

ROAD HAZARD WARRANTY

PROGRAM PROPOSAL FOR MEDIUM TRUCK ROAD HAZARD COVERAGE AT AUTHORIZED DOUBLE COIN DEALER LOCATIONS

This Road Hazard Policy applies exclusively to select Double Coin Radial Truck Tires sold and installed by an authorized Double Coin dealer location in pairs (Steer Axle) or sets of four (Drive & Trailer Axle). The Double Coin Road Hazard Policy at any authorized Double Coin dealer location applies to the first 50% of useable tread wear or six (6) months from date of purchase on invoice, which ever comes first. This policy only applies to tires used in the intended Over-The-Road application. Usable tread wear is calculated based on the original tread depth less $\frac{2}{32}$ " divided by 2. Damaged tire(s) must be inspected at an authorized Double Coin dealer location or by a Double Coin representative in order to receive road hazard policy credit. An unrepairable tire must be replaced with a similar new Double Coin tire at an authorized Double Coin dealer location only. Tires that are repairable will be repaired at no-charge to the customer at an authorized Double Coin dealer location only. A tire is considered repairable based on Tire Industry Association (TIA) standards. An allowance of \$16.00 per tire towards the cost of mounting and balancing will be applied as part of this road hazard policy. Under all circumstances, the cost of applicable taxes (FET, local sales tax, etc.) are required to be paid by the individual/company making the claim.

**The Double Coin Road Hazard Policy applied exclusively to the following patterns, unless otherwise noted:
RR150, TR100, RT500, RLB400, RLB452, FT125, FR610**

EXCLUSIONS

All Double Coin Road Hazard coverage is limited to the original purchaser and the original vehicle on which the tires are mounted. The following are NOT covered by the Double Coin Road Hazard Policy:

- a. Tire branded or marked "Non-adjustable" (N/A) or "Blemished" (Blem), or previously adjusted.
- b. Intentional abuse, including skid or brake lock
- c. Irregular wear
- d. Wreck, collision, fire or vandalism
- e. Mechanical condition of vehicle, including misalignment, wheel balance, faulty shock absorbers or brakes
- f. Misapplication of tire
- g. Alteration of tire or addition of foreign materials
- h. Faulty repairing procedures or materials used in the repairing process
- i. Tires run under-inflated or over-loaded
- j. Loss of time or use, inconvenience, or any incidental and/or consequential damages
- k. Tires operated at speeds that exceed posted limits or used in non-standard applications
- l. Tires used on Off-Highway conditions
- m. Tires with the Department of Transportation (DOT) code removed.
